### Propagation Information

Tray Size: Liner 72, Liner 128

Rooting Hormone: Highly recommended Hormodin 1 IBA

Average days with Mist: 7-14 days on dry or less frequent setting

Pinch: At stick. 0.5-1.0 cm below meristem

Average Propagation Time: 4-5 weeks

Comments: When pinching back flowers, cut low towards the base as to discourage persistence of reproductive growth. Use 14-4-14 fertilizer at 100ppm N when the liners are at a stage 3-4 and are off of mist. Then switch to a 20-10-20 fertilizer at 100-150ppm N at transplant.

Daylength Requirements: 10-12 hour (12 hour including 4 hour extension recommended)

No. of Pinches: 3. At stick, at transplant, 3-4 weeks after transplant to increase branching and reduce early flowering.

6-In (15cm) Pots: 12-14 weeks 3ppp from 128 liner

10 to 12-In (25 to 30cm) Pots: 14-16 weeks, 3 ppp from a 72 liner
